£8.95 per child (3 – 15 years) and concessions

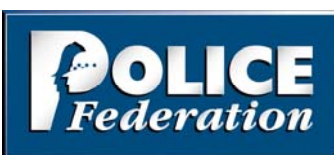
Children aged 2 and under – free admission
