



ST. MICHAEL'S LODGE

St. Michael's Lodge is the North West Police Benevolent Funds brand new facility situated in the beautiful Ribble Vally in Langho (near Clitheroe), Lancashire. It is a small and friendly hotel which is available for use by members of the North West Police Benevolent Fund for short breaks.



This imposing early 20th Century Lodge was initially the village primary school from 1911–1983. After closure the School House remained derelict until conversion to a privately owned hotel began in 1990. In November 2008 the North West Police Benevolent Fund purchased the building and since that date has undertaken further renovations to the building.

As well as the hotel facility, which has nine en-suite bedrooms, St. Michael's will also be used to provide physiotherapy treatment on a day-patient basis, this is intended to compliment the treatment offered by The Police Treatment Centres.

The Trustees of the Fund recognise that some members will not be in a position to attend The Police Treatment Centre for a residential stay and St. Michael's will hopefully allow those members access to physiotherapy treatment previously unavailable to them.

The hotel facility is due to open on Monday 13th September 2010 with bookings being taken now.
